

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully before accessing or using this website. Your privacy is critically important to us. We have a few fundamental principles

1. We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it

Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information

Personally-Identifying Information is any information that that identifies you or would enable someone to contact you. **We collect Personally-Identifying Information when you register to use our services, ask a question, conduct a transaction, or send us an email.** If you do not provide the requested information, you may not be able to access or use some or all of our services.

Disclosure of Personally-Identifying Information

We will not rent or sell Personally-Identifying Information to anyone.

We disclose Personally-Identifying Information only to our employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that: (i) need to know that information in order to process it on our behalf or to provide services available from our website, and (ii) that have contractually agreed not to disclose it to others. Google API Service - User Data Policy

Once you connect your account with our services our application will have access to your calendar, inbox and contacts associated with your Google account, we do not share any of this information with any third party system and/or company.
